Children's Lives Include Moments of Bravery

The CLIMB[®] program at the New Mexico Cancer Center is a special support group developed by The Children's Treehouse Foundation, a non-profit dedicated to the emotional support of teens and children who have parents or guardians with cancer.

Specialty trained facilitators provide this support group that meets Thursday evenings from 6:00 - 7:30pm for 6 weeks. At the start of each session a shared meal is provided by local restaurants for the families. Through art projects and discussion, the structured program helps normalize feelings teens and children may have about their cancer experience and helps nurture positive communication between the parent or guardian with cancer, and their child.
